GOSPEL REFLECTION

Even though we know where GOD ultimately wants us to be – with GOD in heaven for all eternity – it sometimes can cause concern and anxiety as we struggle through life on our journey of faith. We joyfully long to be with GOD, but we are not sure we want to go through the valley of suffering and death to get to the place where we can be with GOD eternally.

The Gospel is from chapter 17 of St. John's Gospel, which is Jesus' prayer for His disciples. Jesus realizes that His time with His followers is drawing to close. The next day (GOoD Friday), He will be crucified and die. And even when He rises on Easter, He will only be with His disciples for a short period of time before He ascends to be with His Abba. Thus with anticipation of what will be happening over the next days, He address His Abba with this prayer for His disciples and for all those who will come into a closer relationship with Him, His Abba, and the Holy Spirit through the ministry of those He sends forth.
